During the academic year 2012-2013 I directed the Bocconi International Theatre Group in another production; "The Dresser" by Ronald Harwood.

During my final year of high school I was elected class representative. Despite heavy academic demands I took the role seriously and made time for constructive liaison between school authorities and students.

I also developed organisational skills through acting as director and overall coordinator of the high-school's theatre activities. My efforts ensured the school drama group's survival through a financially difficult year when lack of funds deprived it of a professional director. In 2008 on my own initiative I directed the making of a short film that was highly ranked in a national schools' contest. Throughout my five years spent at Liceo Classico Romagnosi I acted as organiser and spokesperson for the school drama group.
